OPERATING HOURS & PRICES

The floodlit sled run at the Reiterkogel is included in valid ski tickets.

Operating hours: Daily from 9.00 am to 4.15 pm
Night ascent Monday to Saturday
from 6.00 pm to 9.30 pm
(floodlights until 11.00 pm)

Operating hours of the sled run depend on weather and snow conditions. Use of gondola (also night ascent) is included in valid ski tickets. Night ascent with the Reiterkogel gondola Monday to Saturday from 6.00 pm to 9.30 pm. We ask groups (from 20 people) for pre-booking.

(available at the D1 Reiterkogel base station)

Deposit per Sled € 40.00

(deposit will be refunded only by sled return from Monday to Saturday until 11.00 pm and Sunday until 5.00 pm)

The gondola will not transport other sleds or wintersports equipment!

TIPS & REGULATIONS

1. You sled at your own risk: please always consider the condition of the sled run as well as your own sledding abilities!
2. The track might be difficult to sled due to (e.g. icy) weather conditions. A helmet, sturdy shoes (no ski boots) and good skills are required.
3. Adjust your speed to track and sight conditions as well as your own skills. You should be able to brake at any time. Please always be prepared for oncoming piste preparation vehicles.
4. Please mind all mandatory, danger and warning signs. Sledding on ski slopes is not permitted!
5. The sled run on the Reiterkogel is open from Monday to Sunday until 4.15 pm and from Monday to Saturday additionally from 6.00 pm to 9.30 pm (floodlight until 11.00 pm). Please note the special operating hours of the Reiterkogel gondola!
6. Final control run at 11.00 pm (Monday to Saturday).
7. No skiing on sled runs!
8. The sled track runs from the Wieseralm (Reiterkogel top station), passes Pfefferalm and Goaßstall and ends in the village of Hinterglemm (Reiterkogel base station).

Attention: During day operation, the sled track ends at the height of the Goaßstall!

9. Alcohol consumption increases the risk of injuries and accidents for yourself and others!

SAFETY-SLEDS

The sleds with safety brakes were designed for the Reiterkogel track and are specially equipped to ensure the highest safety standard. The special brake system is easy to operate and ensures fun, but safe sledding. The use of other sleds or wintersports equipment is not permitted.

For your own safety:

The gondola will not transport other sleds or wintersports equipment!
The sled run may only be used with safety sleds owned by the lift operator.
